CLOVIS BANDS RECEIVE SUPERIOR RATING FOR SECOND CONSECUTIVE YEAR

For the second consecutive year, bands from Marshall, Yucca, and Gattis Middle Schools, Clovis High School Freshman Academy, and Clovis High School recently received a Superior rating from the Southeastern New Mexico Music Educators Association's (SENMMEA) Band Large Group Music Performance Assessment.

Superior ratings were received in both of the categories the assessment judges: Concert Performance and Sight-Reading Groups. Groups receiving a score of 90 or higher on a 100-point grading scale are awarded a Superior rating.
