Congratulations to the Clovis High School and Freshman Academy Choral students and their directors, Sean Galloway (CHS) and Tami Martin (CHSFA), as well as the accompanist, Peggy Brady, for an outstanding showing at the Southeast District Solo and Ensemble contest held on the campus of Eastern New Mexico University (ENMU) on October 6, 2016.
