RESERVED SEAT TICKETS

Reserved seat tickets for the 2016 Wildcat & Lady Wildcat basketball season will go on sale Monday, November 7th. Past season ticket holders will have until Monday, November 21st, to purchase their same seats. After November 21st, the remaining seats will go on sale first to individuals on the waiting list and then to the public. If you are a past season ticket holder and you will not be purchasing your seats for the 2016 season, please contact the CHS Athletic Office prior to the November 21st deadline. Reserved seat tickets may be purchased and picked up at the Clovis High School Athletic Office. Cost for reserved seats are \$140 per seat.

The Wildcats & Lady Wildcats will play 29 home games this year. This will include 21 regular season games and 8 tournament games (Plateau Holiday & Wildcat Holiday Tournaments during the Christmas Holidays). The first home game for the Lady Wildcats will be Tuesday, December 2nd in the Clovis Shootout. The first home game for the Wildcats will be Tuesday, November 29th vs Dumas.
