CLOVIS HIGH SCHOOL HEAD FOOTBALL COACH HANGS IT UP AFTER 44 YEARS OF SERVICE

Head football coach, Eric Roanhaus, has decided to resign after forty-four years of dedicated service to Clovis Municipal Schools. Coach Roanhaus has been the head football coach at Clovis High School for thirty-nine years and also served five years as a football, basketball, and baseball assistant coach.

Over forty-four years, Coach Roanhaus worked with ten superintendents, eleven high school principals, and five athletic directors. His career began in 1978 and has achieved the following:

- 489 Games (Most Games Coached ~ State Record)
- 10 State Championships (19 Times in Finals in 39 Years)
- 9 State Runner-Ups
- 28 District Championships (120-24-1 ~ District Record)
- 7 District Runner-Ups
- 62-26 (Playoff Record)
- 40-37 (Texas Record)
- 5 State Championships in a Row (1981-1985 ~ State Record)

Coach Roanhaus said, "I have been very blessed to have had the opportunity to work with some great student athletes and assistant coaches. They both have understood the meaning of hard work and commitment. Our boosters and parents have also been exceptional in their support of our football program."
