CLOVIS HIGH SCHOOL MARCHING BAND PLACES 4th AT THE BANDS OF AMERICA WEST TEXAS REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

The Clovis High School (CHS) Marching Band traveled to Midland, Texas on Saturday, October 14 to compete in the Bands of America (BOA) West Texas Regional Championship.

The band placed 2nd in Class AAA, earned a place in finals competition, and placed 4th overall. This is their second highest placement at a BOA Regional Championship and marks the fifth time the CHS Band has been a finalist in a Regional Championship.

Twenty-three bands competed in the contest and Clovis High School was the only band from New Mexico.

The accomplishment of the CHS Band from the BOA West Texas Regional Championship is best summarized by this statement in an online article from flomarching.com: "The band earned an impressive fourth place against a tough lineup filled with Texas bands at finals."

The success of the band in Midland puts them in a great position as they prepare to defend their State Championship title at the Zia Marching "Fiesta" on the University of New Mexico campus in Albuquerque on October 28, and will have another chance to prove themselves in regional competition when they attend the BOA Utah Regional Championship in St. George, UT on November 4.

The CHS Marching Band is under the direction of Mr. Bill Allred, and is assisted by Ty Frederick, Timothy Clifford, Marcus Flores, Stephanie Lenhart, Melissa Rice-Perez, Daniel Perez, and Savannah Muir.
