CLOVIS STUDENTS PLACE AT FFA STATE LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE

On February 3 - 4, 2017, the Clovis FFA participated in the New Mexico Leadership FFA Conference & Junior High FFA State Contest in Leadership, which was held in Albuquerque.

The conference was full of opportunities for FFA students to grow as leaders as they engaged in an interactive setting to learn skills to use in their chapters, communities, and daily lives.

In the Illustrated Talk competition, students prepare a 4 - 6 minute illustrated talk over an agricultural topic.
