CLOVIS HIGH SCHOOL 2017 VARSITY FOOTBALL SEASON RESERVED SEAT TICKETS GO ON SALE

Reserved seat tickets for the 2017 Wildcat Football season will go on sale Monday, July 31st. Past reserved seat ticket holders will have until Thursday, August 17th, to purchase their tickets. After that date, the remaining tickets will go on sale to the public. If you no longer want to purchase your reserved seat tickets, please contact the CHS Athletic Office prior to the August 17th deadline. Cost for reserved seat tickets are \$60 per seat.

After August 17th, the District will offer discounted tickets to active duty and retired military. Cost for reserved seats, with a military ID card, will be \$30 per seat.

Tickets may be purchased and picked up at the Clovis High School (CHS) Athletic Office, 1900 Thornton Street.

The Wildcats will have five home games this year. The first home game is Friday, August 25th, 7:00 PM, vs. Hobbs. "Homecoming" will be on Friday, September 15th vs. Goddard at 7:00 PM.

Please note, Section A at Leon Williams Stadium will now be general admission seating; Sections B & C will be reserved seating.

General admission tickets for each game will be available in advance at the Clovis High School Athletic Office – \$5.00 for adults, \$4.00 for students 1st- 12th grade, and military/senior citizens \$3.00.

Please note, Family Passes purchased at the High School Athletic Office are no longer accepted for admission into Varsity Wildcat Football games.
