CLOVIS MUNICIPAL SCHOOLS NO LONGER PARTICIPATING IN VACCINES FOR CHILDREN PROGRAM

Clovis Municipal Schools will no longer participate in the Vaccines for Children (VFC) Immunization Program, a federally funded program, which provides no-cost vaccines to children.

Due to increased mandates by the Centers for Disease Control regulating storage, handling, and limited/restricted transport of vaccines, Clovis Municipal Schools decided to explore more community-based options for children to receive vaccines.

Several community providers such as: Curry County Public Health Office, local pediatric and family practice offices, Cannon AFB clinic, La Casa Family Health Center, and Walgreens, Walmart, and Roden-Smith pharmacies can meet your child's vaccination needs, at no cost, on an as-needed basis.
