The Clovis Municipal Schools will be administering a Challenge Exam July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2009 for any student who believes he/she can demonstrate proficiency in the essential knowledge and skills required for the Contemporary New Mexico History course.

A student who has received prior instruction in the course—but did not receive credit for it—may be permitted by the District to earn credit by passing an exam on the essential knowledge and skills defined for the course.

A passing score of no less than 85% is required to receive credit for the course on the student's high school transcript.

There will be a \$25.00 **non-refundable** fee for the exam. Please submit your payment along with this application. Make checks or money orders payable to Clovis Municipal Schools. A study guide will be provided upon receipt of payment.
